

Christian Educator. Provide a teaching ministry including but not limited to such functions as preparing adults and youth for church membership.

Leadership. Guide the spiritual development of the staff and the lay leadership. Lead the congregation in living out their life as the body of Christ.

"Plant A Row" Garden

WPC maintains an all organic raised bed garden on the lawn. Nearly 1,000 pounds of produce are harvested every year. The produce is used to supply the Center for Community Renewal at Saint Mark's Church in Keansburg, NJ. The center provides free meals to the hungry and needy in our area.

Field of Flags

Since 2012, WPC has utilized the front lawn to pay homage to the service men and women of the US military by planting thousands of US flags on the lawn. WPC members and the community help plant the field and a dedication ceremony is held during Veterans Day weekend.

Field of Flags has been a very important and rewarding event for WPC and the greater Middletown community. Over the years the dedication ceremony has been blessed to have marquee names as keynote speakers and helped to honor our Veterans while simultaneously spreading our ministry.
