The Presbytery of the Coastlands PILOT Program on Grants Spring 2024

The Council of the Presbytery of the Coastlands, in an effort to live into its mission statement and missional priorities, announced the formation of a Short-Term Grants Team last summer. After developing a pilot program for the fall of 2023, we are pleased to announce another opportunity to apply this spring. It is based on our mission statement and missional priorities.

Mission Statement, adopted by the Core Transition Team during 2021 – 2022:

Within and beyond:

to share faith,

seek justice,

live into hope,

bear witness,

and practice love.

Missional Priorities, from the Core Transition Team Report, February 28, 2022

- Evangelism
- Pastoral care
- Congregational care

For the pilot cycle (Spring 2024), applications for Presbytery grants will be due April 15, 2024. Awards will be announced no later than May 31, 2024. The Grants Team anticipates there will be two grant cycles per year.

- Spring: Applications due April 15, awards announced May 31
- Fall: Applications due October 15, awards announced November 30

Guidelines

- Congregations and validated ministries within the Presbytery of the Coastlands shall be eligible to apply for grants.
- Grant proposals should align with one or more of the missional priorities of the Presbytery.
 Generally, the greater the duration or value of the proposal, the more missional values it should encompass.
- Application forms will be available via Google Forms, fillable PDF, and paper.
- The Short-term Grants Team consisting of appointees from the Council, Commission on Ministry, and Trustees will evaluate the fall 2023 round of proposals. Criteria will include:
 - o alignment with Coastlands' missional values
 - o clarity of purpose
 - achievability
 - impact on the target community
- The Short-term Grants Team anticipates awarding a mix of small (< \$7,500) through relatively large grants (\$20,000 or more).
- Awardees will be expected to report on their grant within one year.
